Regulations on Dress Code

- B.E. students are strictly required to wear the TU student's uniform to take quizzes, midterm and final exams
- When B.E. students contact the B.E. office, you are required to dress properly, no shorts, no sandals, no sleeveless shirt, no spaghetti straps, and etc.
- B.E. students participating in any university activities such as, field trip, orientation or contacting other organizations as representatives of the B.E. Program have to wear TU student's uniform
- **The B.E. Office reserves the right to provide no services to the B.E. students violating the dress code policy.**

Uniforms Guidelines

Male students

1. White shirt without stripes or prints, a collar is optional. The sleeves must be unrolled and shirt always tucked in.
2. Navy blue or black trousers without stripes, no jeans
3. University logo belt buckle
4. Black loafers with socks

Female students

1. White shirt with short or long sleeves, no stripes or prints. Shirt always tucked in
2. Four silver buttons with University logo (optional). One button must be sewn onto the collar. Pin a brooch with the University logo onto the left side. You may also wear a chain-style brooch, which should be inserted through the button-hole on the collar.
3. Navy blue or black skirt
4. University logo belt buckle
5. Black loafers, shoes or high-heels



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
