Contemporary Issues of ASEAN: CLMV Focus

Course description:

This program is a problem based learning course regarding contemporary issues of ASEAN economic, business, social and political environment. In this program, the student can learn both from lectures (by invited professors and expertise in each topic) in the classroom and field trips to and interview relevant agents in various sectors in Thailand and/or another ASEAN member country regarding issues of focus for the program in that academic year.

Contemporary Issues of ASEAN: CLMV Focus

- Length of the program: 5 weeks (June 8 – July 10 2015)
- Number of credits: 6 credits (Thammasat University credit system)
- Prerequisites: Lecturer's consent (students from various fields of studies could join the program)
- Maximum number of students accepted to the program: 25
