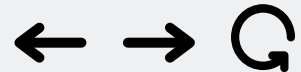

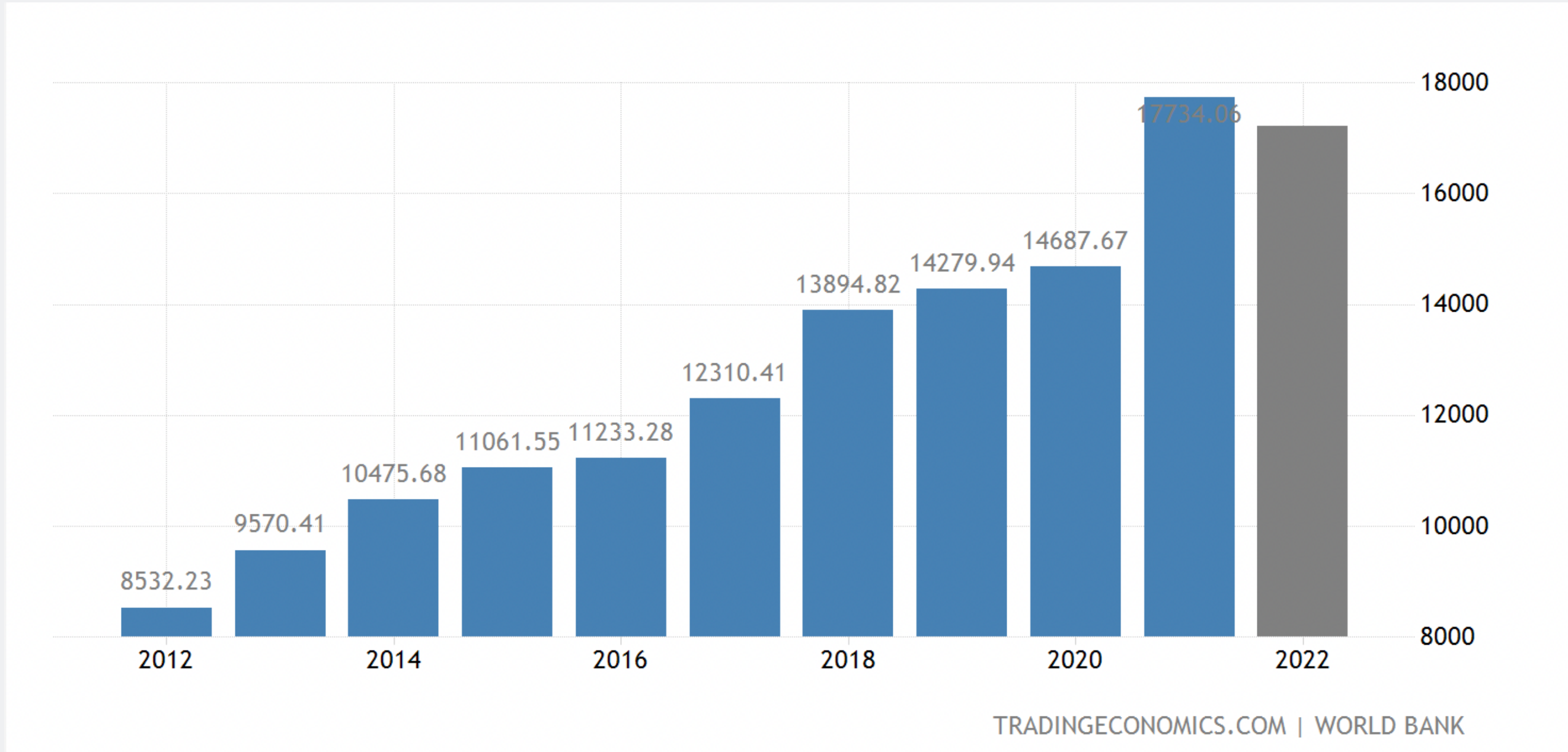

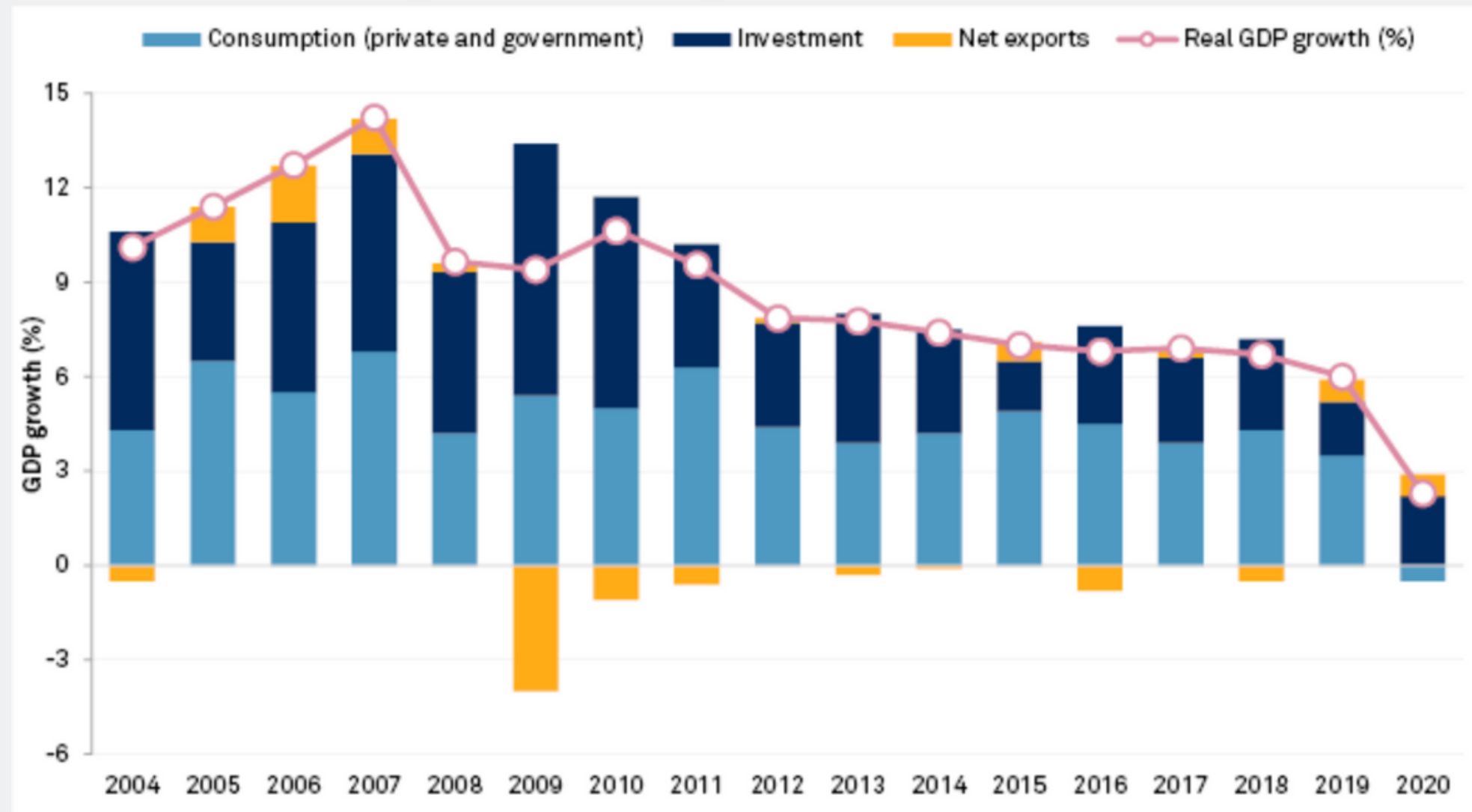
# GDP of China since 2012-2021





# Consumption

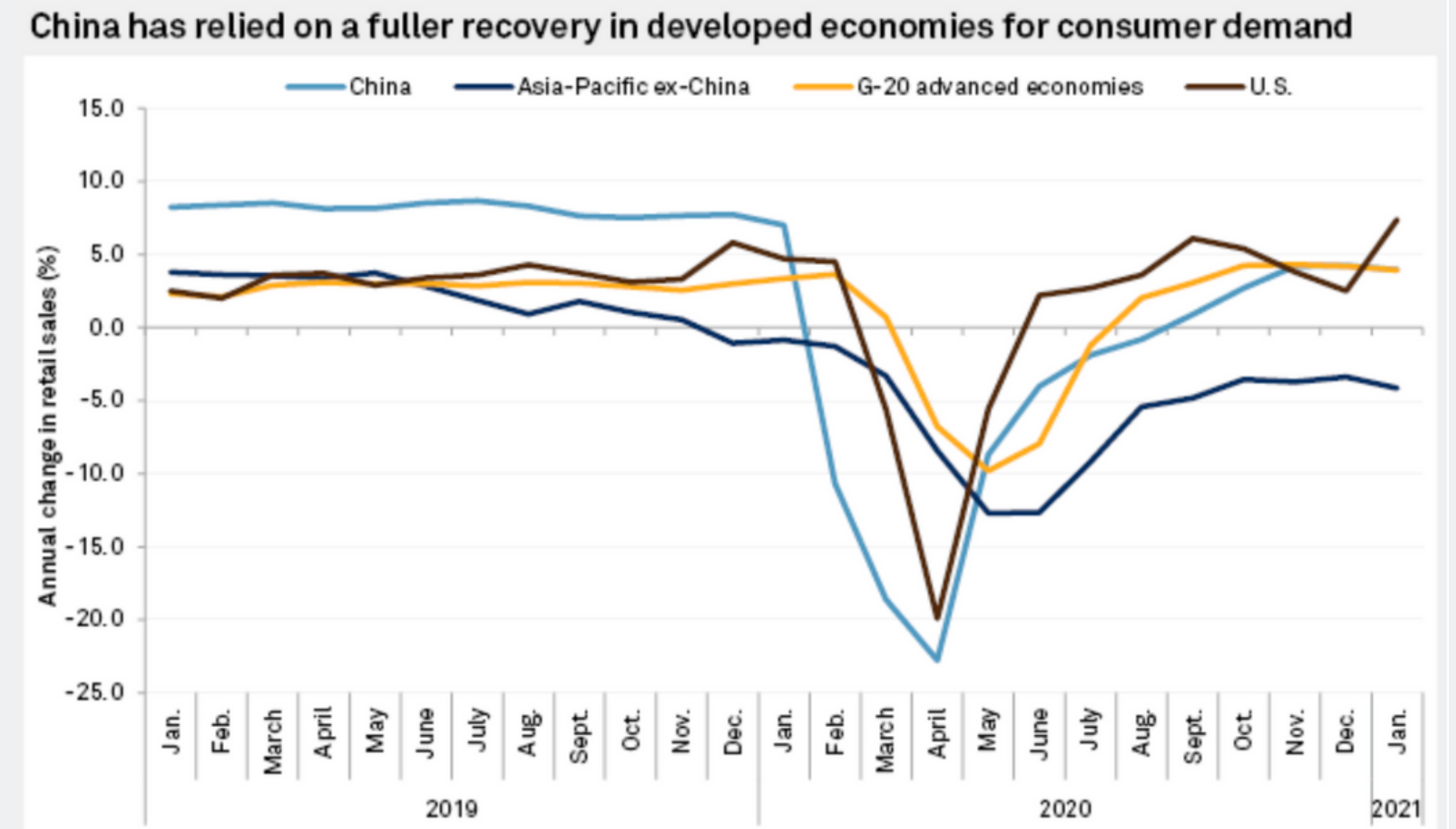
Consumption was a drag on Chinese GDP growth in 2020

- Increase 78 percent of the growth rate of investment in the previous year according to UNCTAD's Investment Trends Monitor released on October 2021





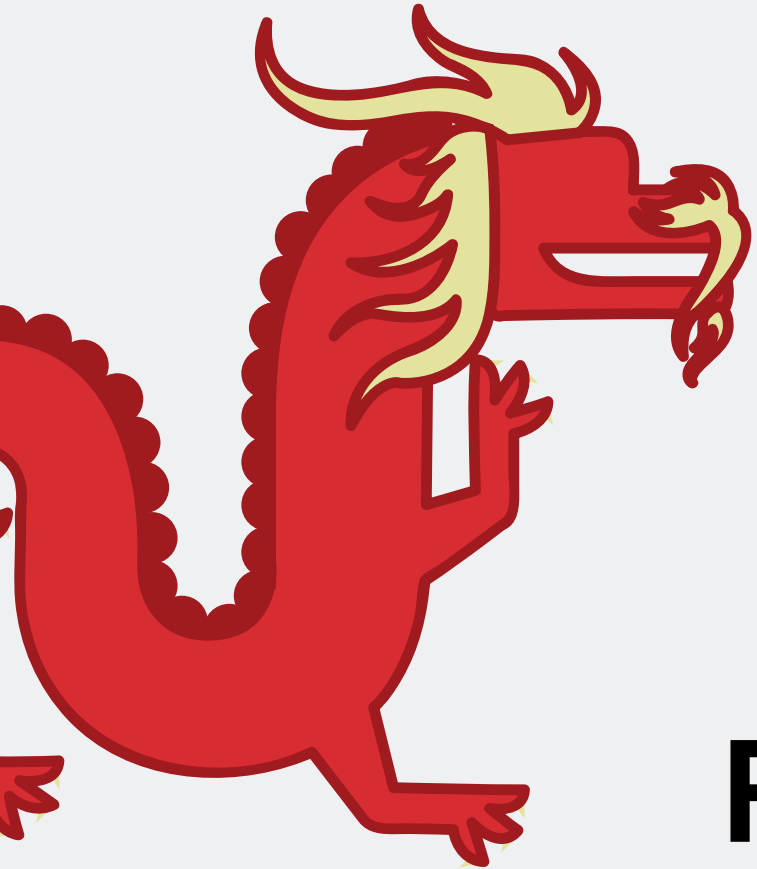

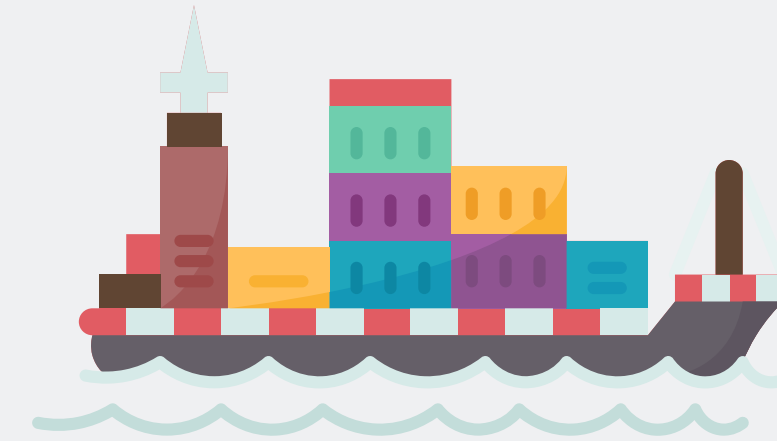

Most export in China are automatic data involved with the components of electricity, such as mobile phones and circuits.



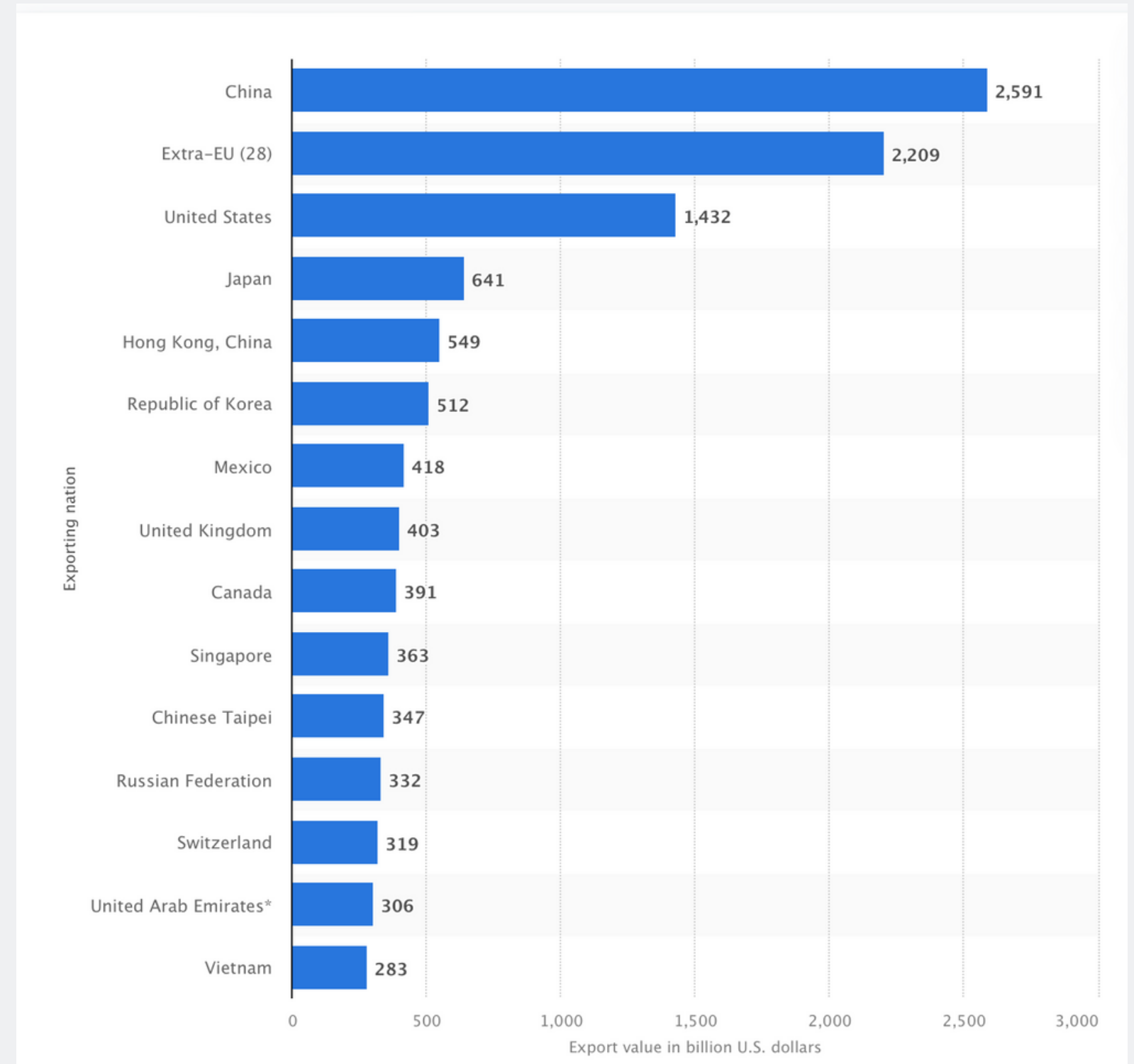
## Import

According to this chart, China is the highest export worldwide and more enhance the growth of the economy in their country, which can affect the GDP

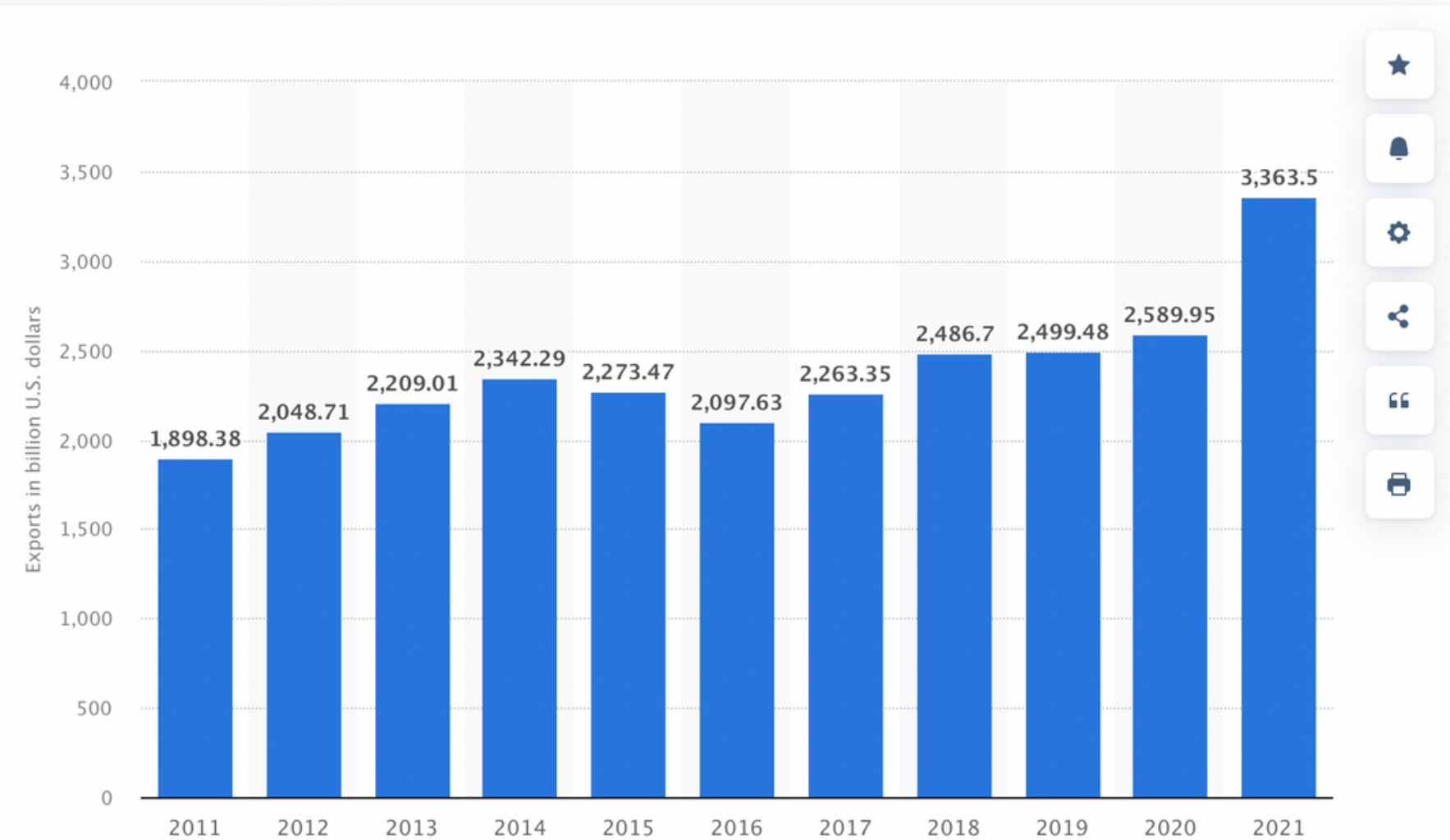




# Export of goods

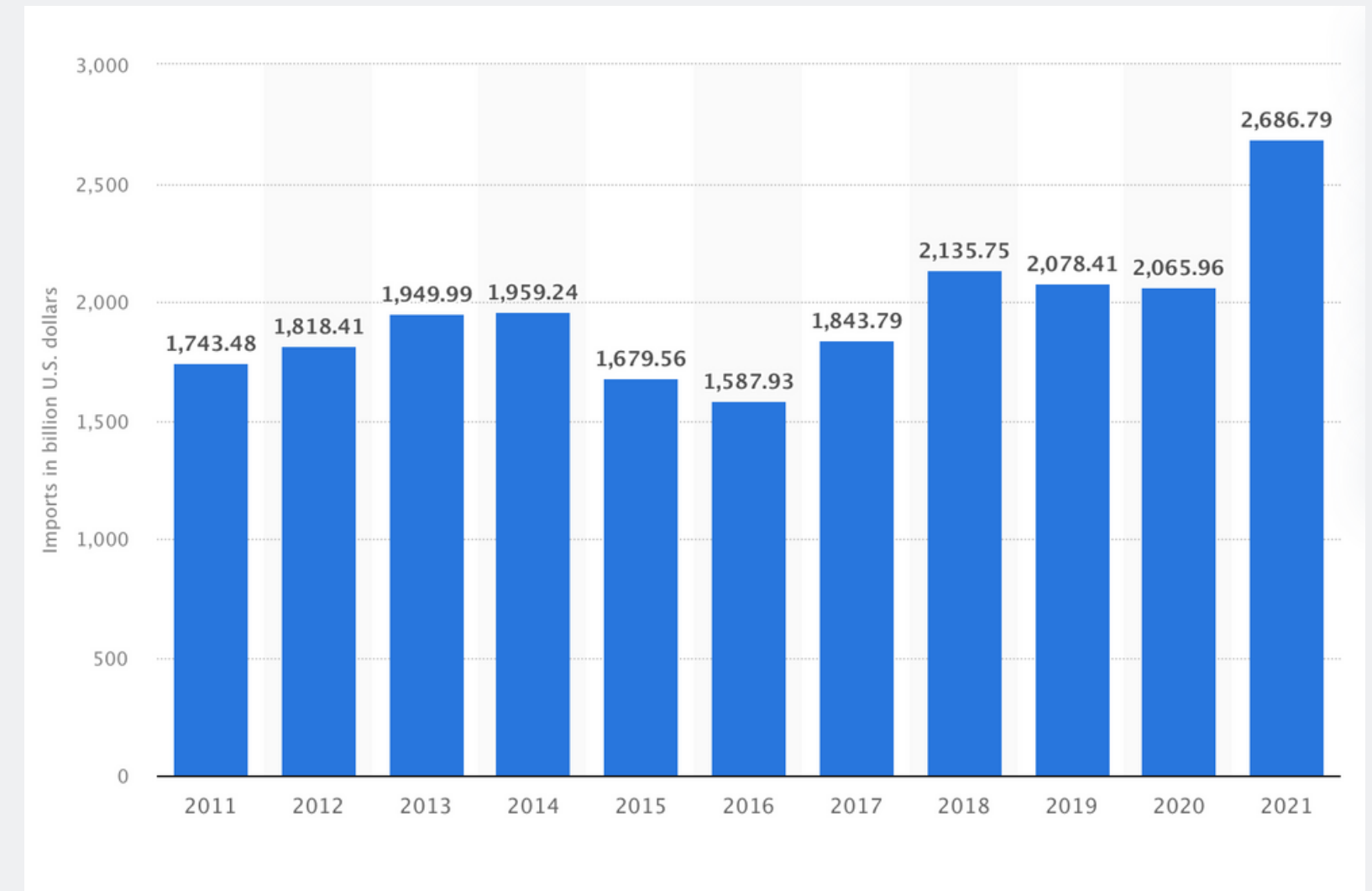

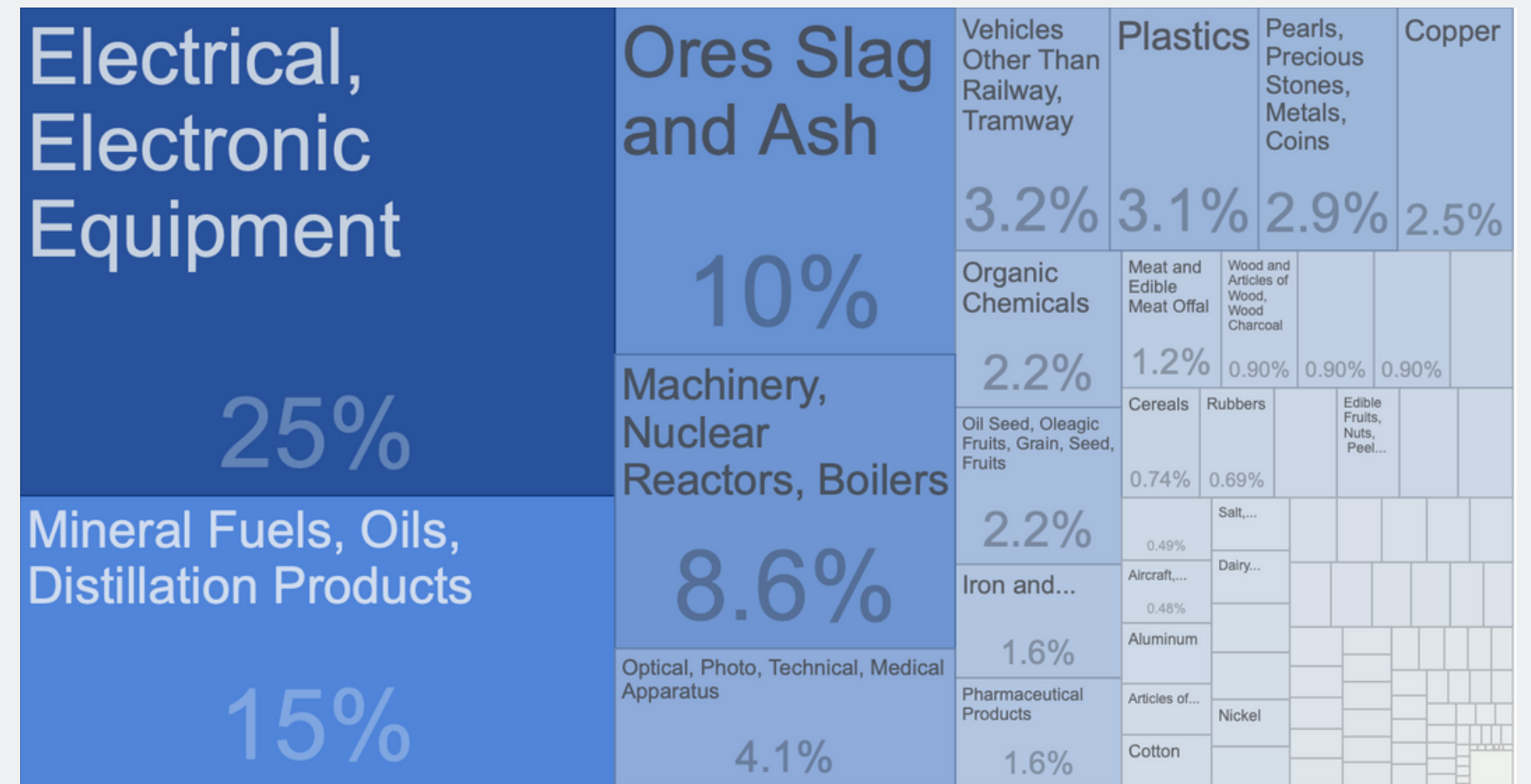
