



Faculty of Economics' Announcement on

Studying in Economics courses curriculum 2009

1. According to Thammasat University regulations, at least half of a student's entire registered credits must consist of EE courses or the following courses:
 - 1.1. General Education Courses Part I (TU110, TU120, TU130, TU152, EL171, EL172, and TH161)
 - 1.2. General Education Courses Part II
 - 1.3. Compulsory Courses in Economics (MA216, ST216, EL241, EL341, AC201, FN201, ST217, and MA217)
2. In 2009 curriculum, item No. 17.3.5, students in Faculty of Economics must obtain not below 2.00 GPA in Economics courses (EE courses) including the following courses:
 - 2.1. Compulsory Courses in Economics
 - 2.2. Cluster-specific compulsory courses
 - 2.3. Electives in Economics
 - 2.4. Seminar

This regulation applies to students I.D. No. 54xxxxxxx onwards
3. Nomination for Honor
According to Thammasat University regulations No. 22.2.2 (3) "Major area course" refers to all EE courses.

This regulation applies to students I.D. No. 52xxxxxxx onwards
