

Notification on preregistration requests

Requests for EE courses

1. Due to limited preregistration demand, only one section will be offered for EE451 and EE452. The second section will be closed. Instructors for the sections are as follows:
 - 1.1 EE451: Associate Professor Chayun Tantivasadakarn, Ph.D.
 - 1.2 EE452: Assistant Professor Rungnapa Opartpunyasarn, Ph.D.
2. Given the computer room's limited capacity, all requests made for EE200/EE300 will be denied. Students are advised to enroll in this course next year.
3. All request made for EE361 Economics of CLMV Countries are approved only for students with ID.61. Students with ID62 should consider taking the course next year.
4. All requests made for all other EE courses are approved.

Requests for Non-EE courses and Gen Ed part II

1. All requests made for TU116 are denied. Students are advised to enroll in other GEN ED part II courses offered this semester, or wait to enroll next year.
2. Given the high demand for TU122, two more sections will be offered. Instructors for each section are as follows:

3. All requests for FN211 are approved only for students minoring in Finance. Those who choose to minor in MK or free cluster, please consider enrolling in this course next year.
4. All requests made for MK323 are approved only for students minoring in Marketing. Those who plan to minor in Finance or free cluster, please consider enrolling in this course next year.
5. There has been overwhelming demand for AC201 enrollment from students with ID63. Unfortunately, current semester capacity only permits a maximum of two sections, with 60 students each. To allocate the quota and resolve problems of students who cannot reach the quota as requested for the current semester, the following procedure has been instituted:

5.1 AC201 will be offered twice on Fridays.
(Section 046401) will begin at 9am until noon.
(Section 046402) will be from 2pm to 5pm.
Each section will accept 60 students. The quota will be assigned on a first come, first served basis.

5.2 Students unable to enroll in either of the two sections will have a reserved place for enrollment during the summer term for one section (with quota of 60 students only). The summer term section will be reserved exclusively for students with ID63.

Note that students who (i) cannot reach the quota in the current semester and (ii) have the overlapped class schedule with EE212 will receive the first priority for the assignment of quota in the summer term.
