Capstone Project mini

This project is weighted 20% of the total score of this semester.

Objectives:

1. To gain experience on how to raise a good research question and how to find answers to it.
2. To apply knowledge from classes and elsewhere, regarding behavioral finance, in a problem-based fashion.
3. To practice on analytical and writing skills.

Output:

The reference point is 4-page A4 with Times New Roman 12, single line spacing. This is about **2,000 words**. This length is a reference point for your content, and not including the reference.

Any source of information you used **must be** cited properly in the reference, otherwise your work will be considered invalid due to plagiarism.

You could imagine this capstone project mini as writing a short piece of analysis for economics/finance journals.

Instruction:

1. Raise a research question regarding behavioral finance. It can be within the content covered throughout this semester, or beyond.
2. Provide your analysis, discussing the answers or the methodology to get to the answers of your research question.
3. In your work, there should be introduction, body, and conclusion. Please state clearly (a.) what your research question is; (b.) why it is important to know the answer (your motivation); and (c.) what the answers and implications are.
4. You can work individually or as a group with the maximum of 4 people.

Criteria:

The research project will be graded based on:

1. how well you raise your research question
2. how well your analysis is in order to answer your question.

It is not necessarily true that longer writing renders better quality of analysis.

Number of group members will be factored in the grading process.
