### Final Examination Code of Conduct

1. All students are advised to arrive at the examination venue before the exam begins.
2. Students may **not** enter the examination room **unless permitted** by the supervisor.
3. Students must follow the uniform dress code as guided by the university regulations.
4. Students must show their student ID card upon entering the examination room.
5. Students may **not** leave the examination room **unless permitted** by the supervisor.
6. Should students come late, they may enter the exam room only if they come within the first 30 minutes from the start of the examination period.
7. During the examination, students must not speak, communicate, or behave in any ways that could indicate the action of misconduct or cheating.
8. Students may address their queries to the supervisor **only**.
9. Students **are not permitted** to bring textbooks, handouts, notes, calculators, pencil cases and mobile phones into the examination room unless there is an approval announced earlier by the Program.
10. Students are **not** allowed to leave the examination room during the first 30 minutes of the examination period.
11. Students will be notified about 10 minutes prior to the end of the examination period.  
Once the examination period is over, students must discontinue doing the exam paper.
12. Upon submission, students must place their exam papers and answer sheets on their desks. Students may leave the examination room only after their papers have been collected.
13. Upon leaving the examination room, students must refrain from making excessive noise.

Students caught cheating or attempting to cheat will **earn the “F” grade for that subject and will be suspended for 1 academic year** as stated in the student ethical code guided by the university regulations.
