

COVID–19 Pandemic Relief Measures

To relieve financial burdens of parents and B.E. students affected by the COVID–19 pandemic, the B.E Program is proposing the following support guidelines for students registering for semester 1, academic year 2021:

1. Tuition Fee Installment Plan

The B.E. Program is proposing an installment payment plan for tuition fees for semester 1/2021. All B.E. tuition fees for semester 1/2021 will be paid in three equal installments:

Installment	Due date
1	16 – 18 July 2021
2	20 – 22 August 2021
3	20 – 22 September 2021

For smooth tuition fee payment processing, please note the semester 1/2021 registration schedule and instructions carefully:

1.1 Students must complete course registration on the Office of the Registrar website (<http://www.reg.tu.ac.th>) by following this schedule:

1.2 The first installment shall be paid by TU GREATS application (app), equal to 1/3 of the total tuition fee amount. (Each installment is automatically calculated by the TU GREATS app.)

1.3 Registration for students who have not completed items 1.1, and 1.2 will be considered incomplete and all reserved quotas cancelled. As a result, students with cancelled quotas due to incomplete first installments must register during the add/drop period and pay the first and second installments together on 20 – 22 August 2021 (including late registration fee).

1.4 Adding and dropping shall proceed as usual. Tuition fees during the add/drop period will be divided by remaining installment(s) and added to each outstanding amount(s).

1.5 Students must follow the registration and payment instructions as specified in this announcement. The right to reserve quotas for semester 2/2021 on the BE Portal system will be suspended for those who do not complete registration and payment on schedule.

2. Measures for Tuition Fee Assistance during the COVID–19 Pandemic

If the Thammasat University has the policy on measures for tuition fee aid during the COVID - 19 pandemic in semester 1/2021, the B.E. program will update students with confirmed details and the logistic processes as soon as these are determined.

3. Specific Assistance Measures

The B.E. Program is currently consulting with the TU Faculty of Economics to approve and establish a COVID–19 Hardship Fund. Details about the application period and requirements will be updated around the start of semester 1/2021.
