

Announcement of the Honor Thesis Guidelines Academic Year of 2022

According to the Bachelor of Economics International Program Curriculum of 2018, eligible students who are interested to complete the degree with the honor thesis track are required to register in EE400: SEMINAR HONORS THESIS in the first semester of the final academic year, and register in EE500: HONOR THESIS in the final semester of their study.

To facilitate the process and follow the protocol of the academic department of Econ-TU, the BE International Program would like to announce the following guidelines for pursuing the capstone project via the honor thesis track for the academic year 2022:

Year 4: Semester 1 (EE400)

1. Contact, and **confirm the primary advisor before the semester starts.** Lists of eligible advisors for the academic year 2022, and their areas of expertise are provided at the BE Office upon request.
2. Use the [BE General Request Form](#) that is available on the [BE Moodle website](#), and submit a request to register in **EE400: SEMINAR HONORS THESIS** with the **primary advisor's signature on the instructor's block.** (Make sure your request has reached the office by August 5th, 2022. Send your request to be_thammasat@econ.tu.ac.th).
3. Complete the registration of **EE400** during the Add/Drop period (8th – 21st August 2022) via REG TU, and complete the payment via TU GREATS application.
4. Begin the seminar honor thesis, and propose the topic of the honor thesis under the supervision of the advisor.
5. Request a proposal defense to the BE Program **before the last day of the semester AND at least 2 weeks before the date you schedule the proposal defense.** The thesis proposal **MUST** be submitted with the request (Use the BE general request form). The thesis proposal is required to follow the Thammasat

University Thesis Manual 2021. The manual and template can be downloaded from <https://web.tulibs.net/academic-support/thesis-templates-manuals>.

6. Students are required to pass the proposal defense before the last day of final examination period of the semester.

Remark: Students are required to maintain the GPA of 3.25 or above, and have passed at least 3 courses of EE4XX level before registering in EE400.

Year 4: Semester 2 (EE500)

1. Confirm your continuation on **EE500: HONOR THESIS** with the BE office by the date for which you have passed the proposal defense.
2. Register in **EE500: HONOR THESIS** with the passing credits of EE400: SEMINAR HONOR THESIS in the previous semester.
3. Conduct the honor thesis under the supervision of the advisor.
4. Use [BE General Request Form](#), and submit a request for thesis defense to the BE Program **before the last day of the semester AND at least 2 weeks before date that you schedule the thesis defense.** The thesis proposal is required to follow the Thammasat University Thesis Manual 2021. 5. Students are required to pass their thesis defense before the last day of final examination period of the semester.
