Remarks:

1. The online registration system will open on November, 19 - 22, 2013 at 9AM.
2. Please check your financial status for registration promptly. If payment is still required, contact the B.E. office.
3. Registration is complete when payment has been registered. Any student who cannot follow the schedule, please fill in a request form and submit it in person at the B.E. office or at [patcharapim@econ.tu.ac.th](mailto:patcharapim@econ.tu.ac.th) before noon on Monday, November 18, 2013.
4. Students whose payments are not registered by November 25, 2013 will have their registered courses deleted from the system. Students may register again during the add&drop period (January 13 to 27, 2014) but must pay a penalty of 45 baht/day starting from January 13, 2014. Students may not be able to re-register if classes are full.

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| <b>Registration Instructions</b> |
|----------------------------------|

1. **At least half of any student's registered credits must consist of EE and /or TU courses (including AC201, FN201, MA217, ST217).**
  2. In a single semester, students may only register for one principle economics course (EE211, EE212, EE311 and EE312).
  3. Students must complete all prerequisites for courses.
  4. Any course with fewer than 20 enrolled students will be cancelled unless the B.E. office announces otherwise.
  5. Any student who wishes to audit a class must submit a request form at the B.E. office before the semester starts. Students may register as auditors only when approved by advisers and instructors.
  6. Students may only register once. Further changes after registration may be made only during the add&drop period.
- Note: To verify registration, click “confirm” on the first page and “re-confirm” on the second page of your browser.**
7. Do not leave selected course(s) in the table on the registration page if you do not intend to choose them.
  8. Payment may be made in cash by submitting an invoice with bar code at any Kasikorn Bank service counter. The Kasikorn Bank will report your payment to the B.E. office and students need not deliver the transfer slip to the B.E. office.
  9. Any student who chooses to register for course(s) that require a lecturer's consent must submit a request form noting her/his recent academic record to the B.E. office in person or

to [patcharapim@econ.tu.ac.th](mailto:patcharapim@econ.tu.ac.th) by noon on Monday, November 18, 2013. Your request will be submitted for consideration.

10. Any student who participated in the exchange program and whose transfer credits are still pending but needed as prerequisites cannot enroll online. These students must submit a request form at the B.E. office in person or to [patcharapim@econ.tu.ac.th](mailto:patcharapim@econ.tu.ac.th) by noon on Monday, November 18, 2013.

### **I. Overlapping of minor courses and required courses for each cluster (Curriculum 2009).**

Students who choose minor courses which overlap with required courses in their clusters, such as the monetary and financial economics cluster which consists of AC201, FN201, EE431, EE432, EE435, and EE452 as required courses and also take minor courses in finance such as AC201 and FN201. Credits are counted only once for overlapping courses, so some credit will be lacking when it is time for you to graduate. In this case, students may take any courses offered by Thammasat University (not including general education courses) to replace missing credits.
