1.2. *Chalida* bought a limited edition DREAM ON handbag for 100,000 Baht. *Pananya* wanted that bag but had no money. She decided, without thinking about a risk of losing her job at TU, to snatch the bag from *Chalida*. *Chalida* immediately seized it back.

1.3. While *Chalida* and *Pananya* fought, *Chalida*'s arm was injured. *Chalida*'s mom demands compensation from *Pananya*.

1.4. *Chalida*'s mom knew about *Chalida*'s expensive *Dream On* handbag and did not agree with her decision to buy it. *Chalida*'s mom goes to the shop and demands money back.
