- Price Index (PI)
- CPI : consumer goods, bread, milk, clothing, transportation, telecommunication, etc.
- Any individual's basket may differ from the "marketed" basket used to calculate CPI.
- A "base year" has to be chosen carefully; the prices should not be unnaturally high or low. (Taste and availability change a great deal over time. Typically, recent years are chosen.)
- GDP deflator is a Price Index, the (weighted) average prices of all final goods and services.
