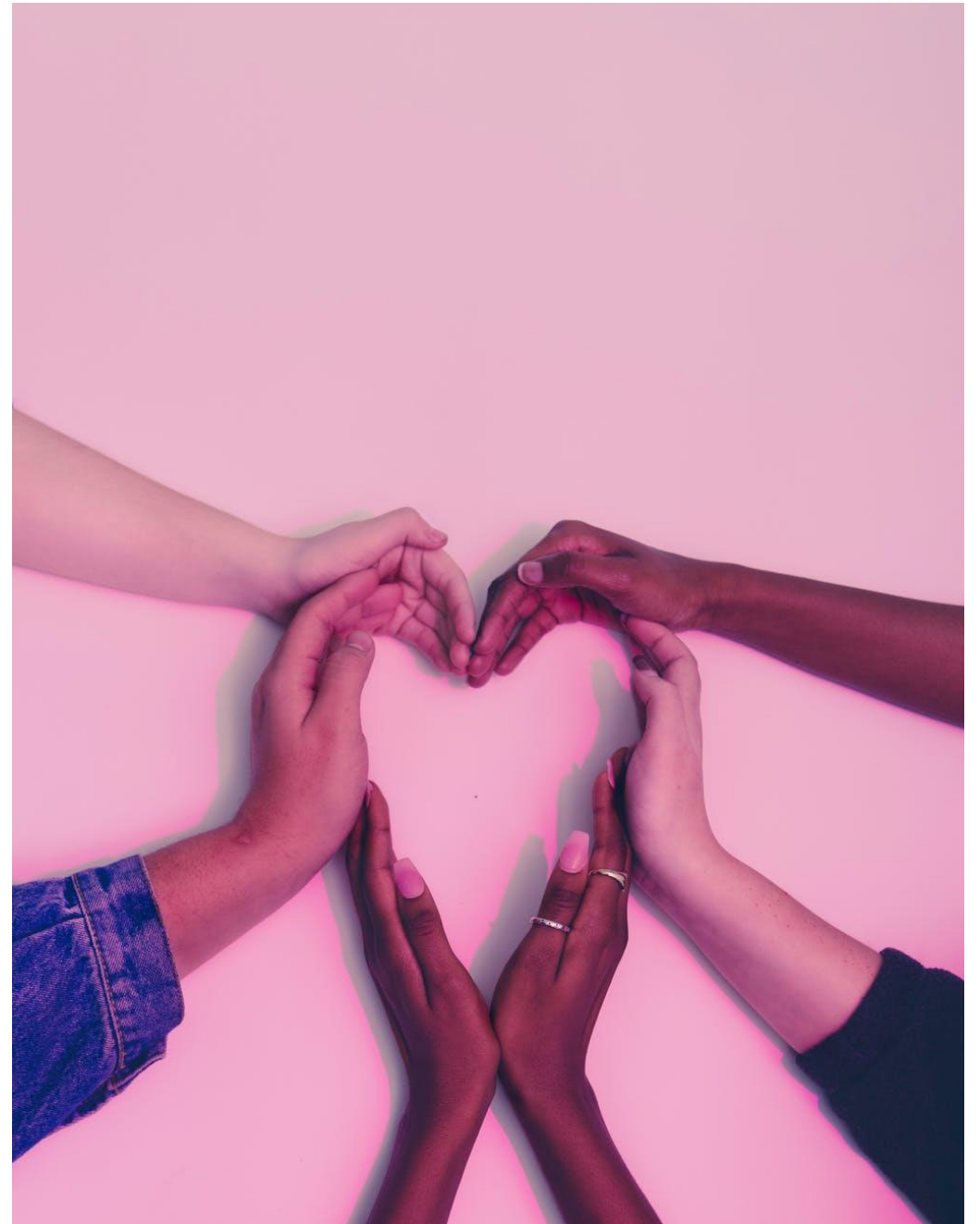

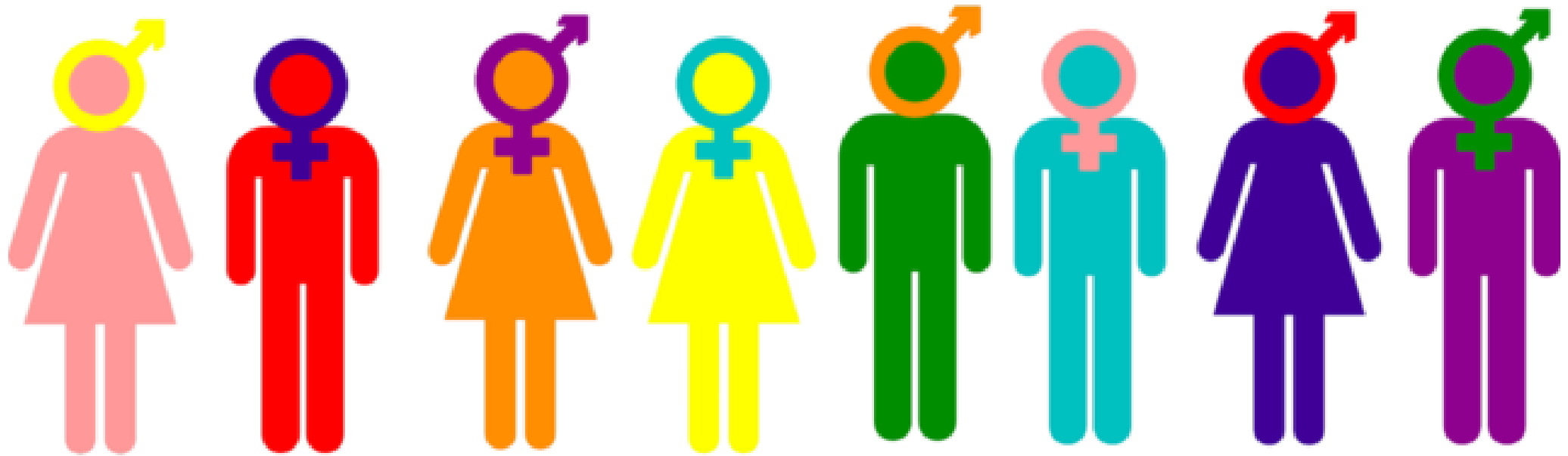
IS IT WHEN PEOPLE HAVE SEX INTERNATIONALLY?

Intersex people are born with any combination of **sex characteristics that do not fit the “typical” idea of a male or female body.** This could include variations in hormones, internal anatomy, genitals, and chromosomes.

0.05% TO 1.70% of the population is born with an **intersex trait.** The upper number makes being born intersex as common as being born a redhead!¹

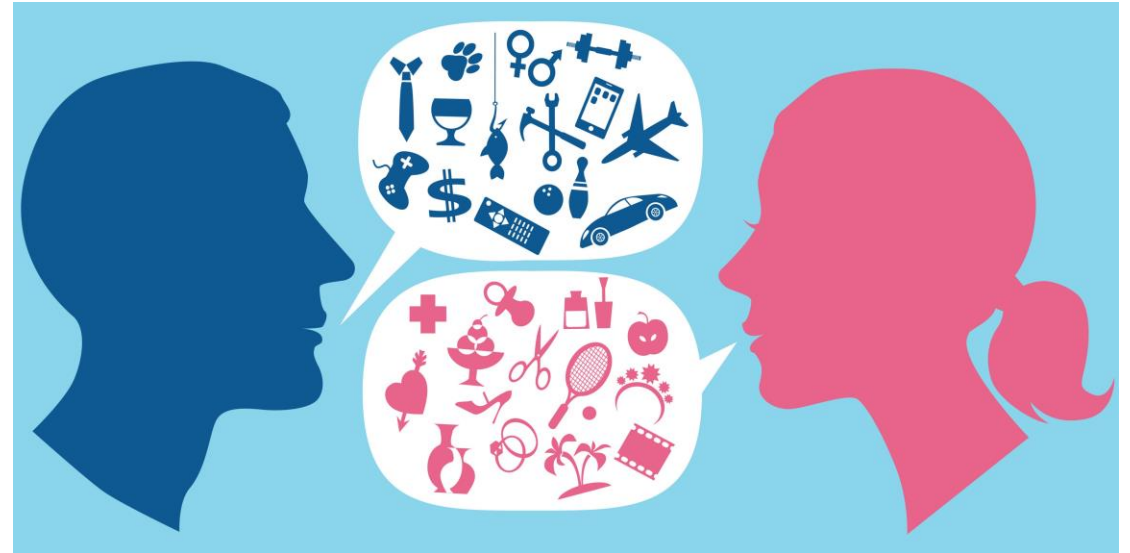

TRANSGENDER

Some transgender people might have surgery, take hormones or change the way they look or dress to bring their body into alignment with how they identify, but not all transgender people can or want to do this. Being transgender is not dependent on your physical appearance or medical procedures. Hence, the importance of not reducing a person to their genitals (whether they have a penis or vagina). Anyway, does it really matter? How is this any of my business?



Gender can be fluid.

Gender Fluid

A person whose gender identity is not fixed and / or shifts depending on the situation. These people don't feel the need to act according to the sex they were assigned at birth and the associated traditional social roles.





Non-binary

Some people don't identify with any gender. Some people's gender changes over time. People whose gender is not male or female use many different terms to describe themselves, with non-binary being one of the most common. Other terms include genderqueer, agender, bigender, and more.

B = Bisexual (attracted to males *and* females)

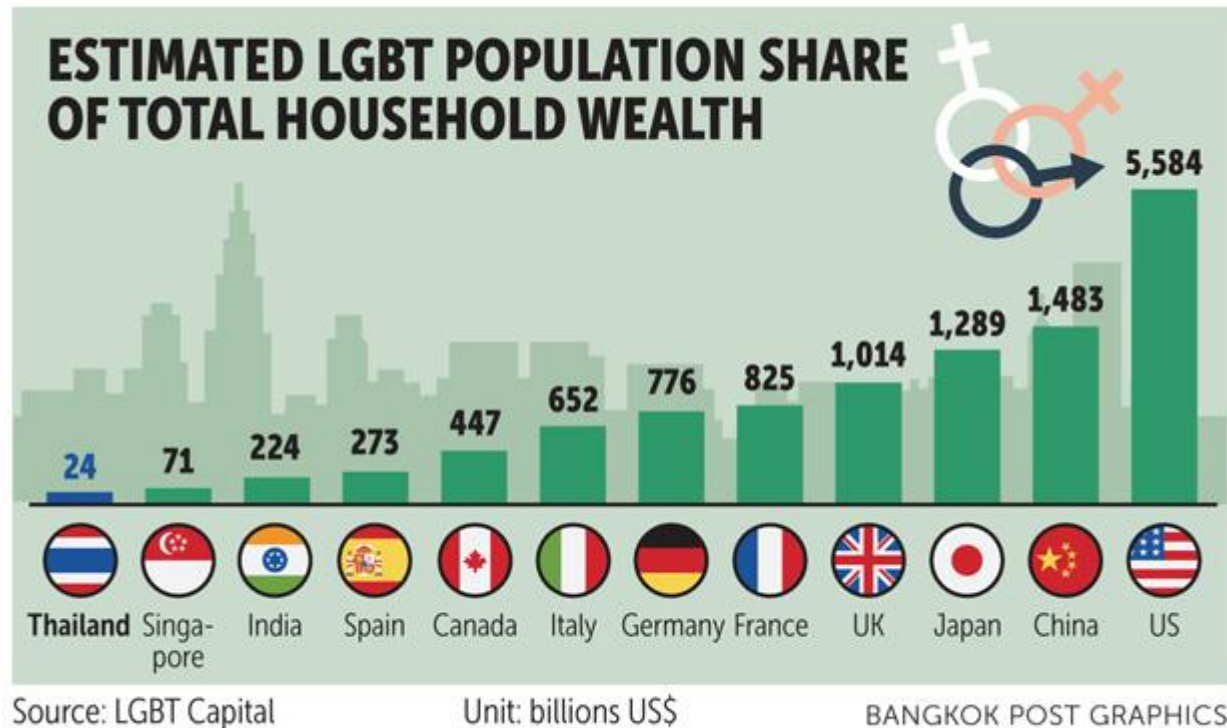
T = Transgendered (doesn't fit social conventions matching birth gender)

LGBT Chinese flocking to buy Thai property



Bangkok and Phuket are the top two destinations in Southeast Asia for LGBT Chinese looking for condos to live in because such buyers feel comfortable in these cities, says Juwai.com, a Chinese international real estate website.

The website's chief executive, Carrie Law, said mainland Chinese buyers who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual or transgender (LGBT) probably account for 5-8% of total property-buying inquiries in Bangkok.

Chinese buyers made nearly US\$1 billion (32.7 billion baht) worth of buying inquiries in Bangkok over the past 18 months, placing LGBT inquiries at about \$50-80 million.

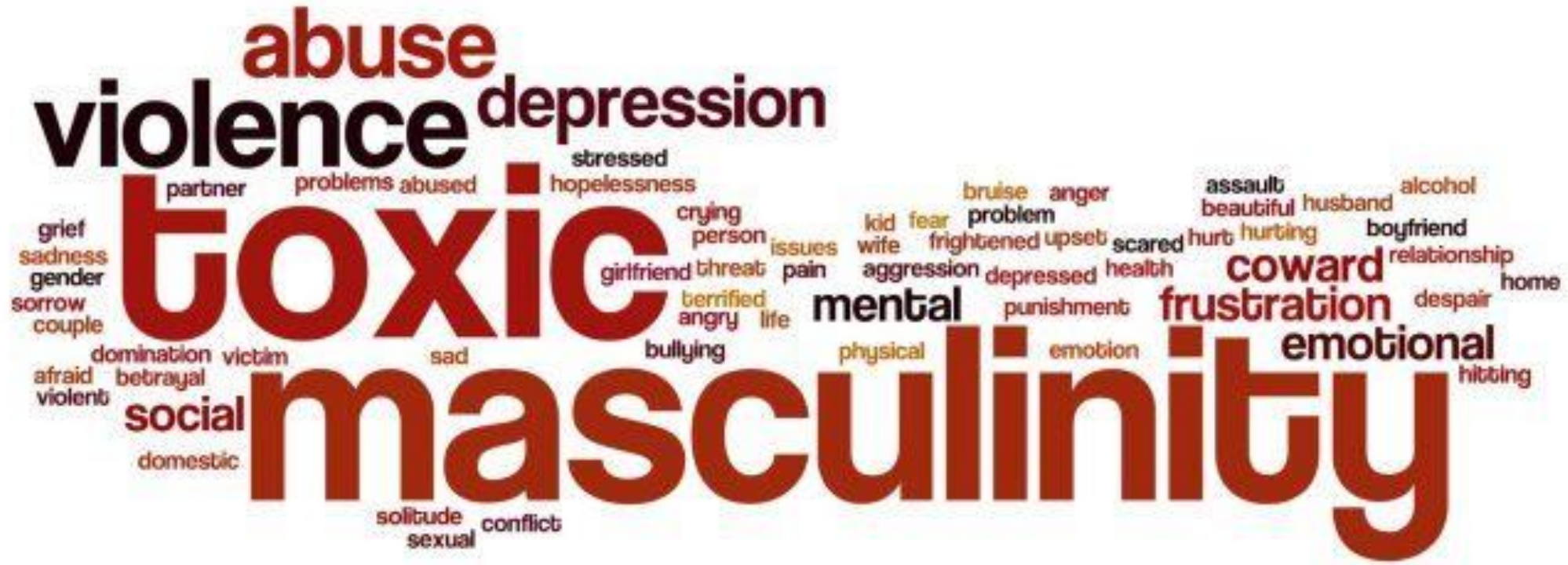

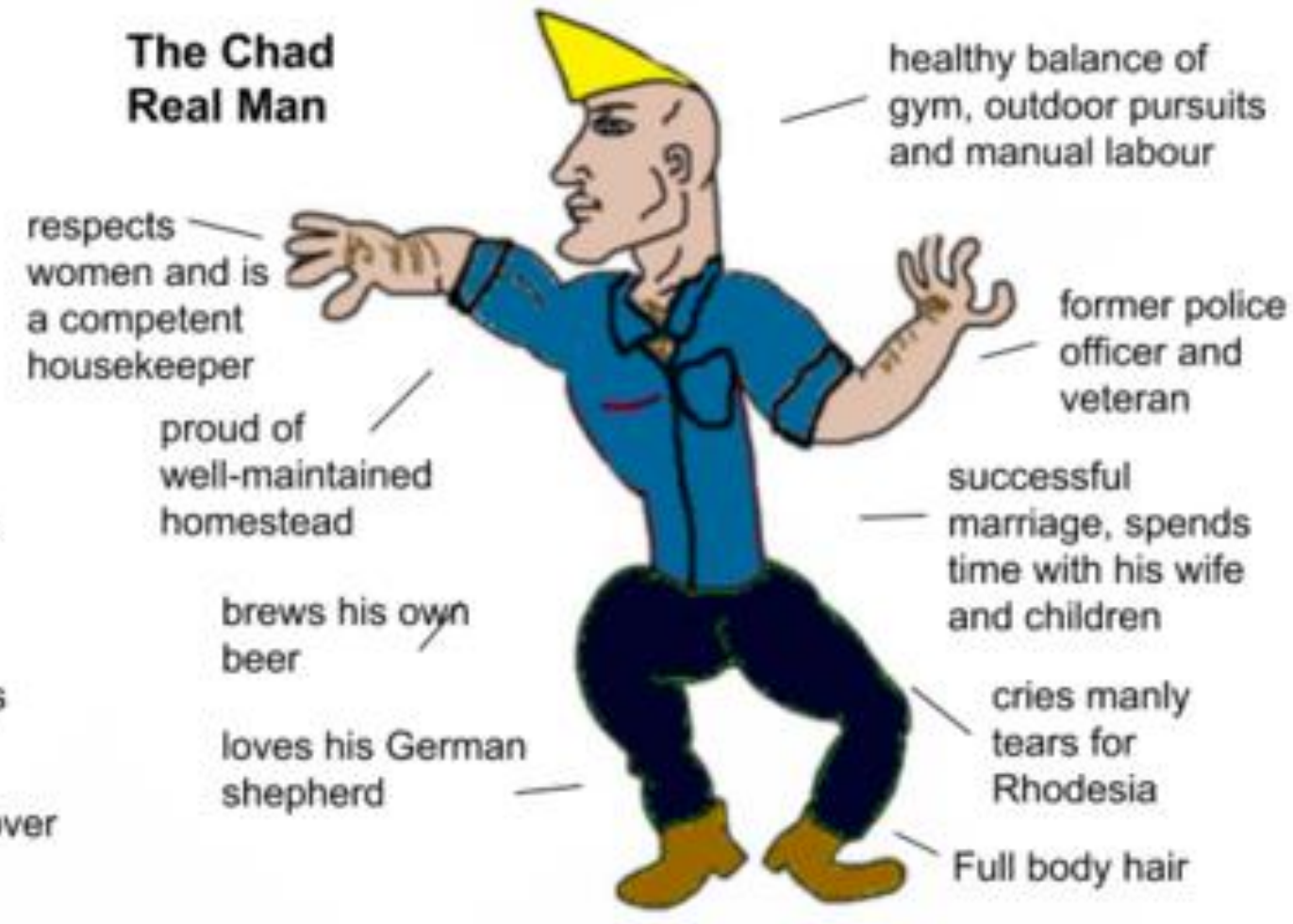
