Q1

Some of the water resources management are:-

1. Floods are defined as the inundation of huge areas of land by water after they have been dry for a period of time. Agriculture, livestock, and property all suffer significant losses as a result of the flood.
2. Salty groundwater-A significant percentage of sodium salts can be found in most dry and semi-arid environments. This type of water is hazardous to agriculture. Continuous use of such water causes sodium salts to build up in the soil, resulting in Usar or alkali soil.

Q2

Government failure is a type of market failure that occurs in the public sector. When the market fails, the government gets involved, resulting in a more inefficient distribution of goods and resources than would otherwise occur which could be a source of inefficient allocation of land.
