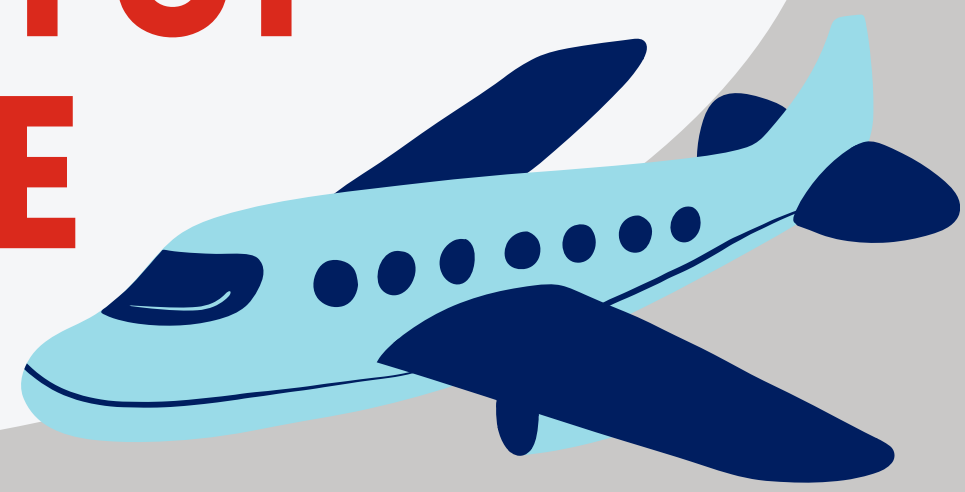
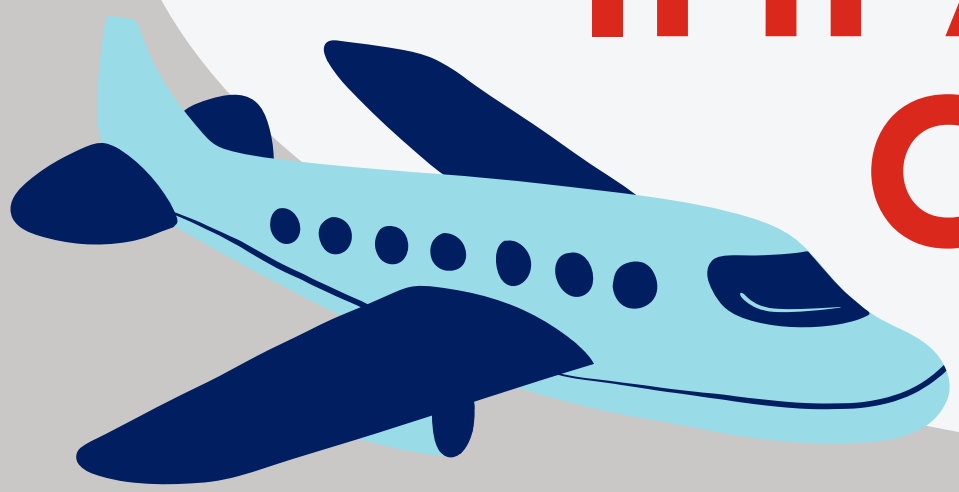


GLOBAL IMPACT STARTUP CHALLENGE



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



WHAT IS THE GLOBAL IMPACT STARTUP CHALLENGE ABOUT?

The Global Impact Startup Challenge (ISC) is an intensive one-week entrepreneurship bootcamp where aspiring young entrepreneurs will collaborate across diverse cultures and learn to develop impactful startup ideas.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The Global ISC is designed for tertiary and pre-tertiary students passionate about social change and innovation, have entrepreneurial interest, and are able to converse in English. We welcome students with no entrepreneurship experience!

WHY SHOULD I PARTICIPATE?

Students can expect to engage in cross-cultural collaborations, learn entrepreneurship concepts and tools, validate their startup ideas across borders, and pitch them to a panel of investors. Upon completion of the Global ISC, students will receive a Certificate of Completion issued by SUSS.

Programme Dates (in-person at SUSS, Singapore): 22-28 July 2024

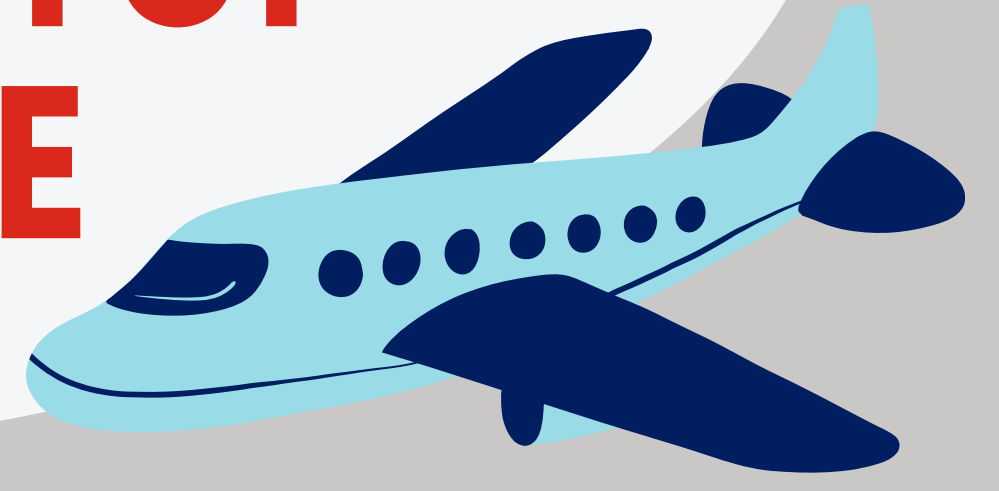
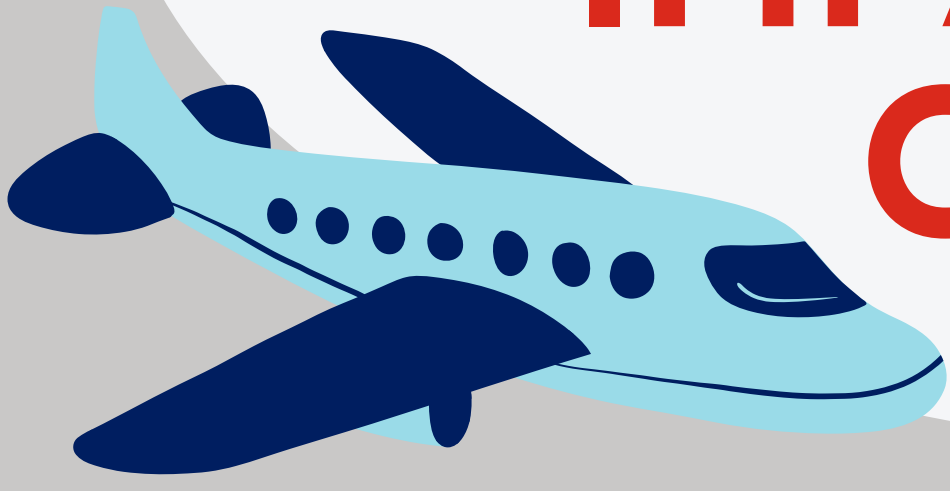


WHAT ARE THE PARTICIPATION COSTS?

There will be a programme fee of 550 USD (approximately 750 SGD), which covers accommodation (twin-sharing room), breakfast and lunch (halal certified), welcome dinner and site visits to Singapore's startup ecosystem.

Other expenses not covered in the programme fee may include flight to/from Singapore, dinner, personal expenses, travel insurance and visa (if necessary).

WILL I NEED A VISA?

Specific countries need to apply for visa before entering Singapore, please check the following website for more information https://www.ica.gov.sg/enter-transit-depart/entering-singapore/visa_requirements

WHEN DO I HAVE TO ARRIVE IN SINGAPORE?

Please arrive by 22 July 2024. Students will have to make their own flight arrangements. Accommodations will be available from 3:00PM onwards on 22 July 2024.

WILL THERE BE ACCOMMODATION?

Yes, a 6-night accommodation is included in the programme fee. Students will stay at a hotel in a twin-sharing room. Room allocation will be released at a nearer date.

WHAT IS THE WEATHER LIKE IN SINGAPORE?

Singapore is typically humid with an average temperature around 28 - 32 degrees Celsius and some expected rain. However, it might be cold in air-conditioned places. It is recommended to pack appropriately (i.e., light clothing, umbrella, a jacket, etc.).

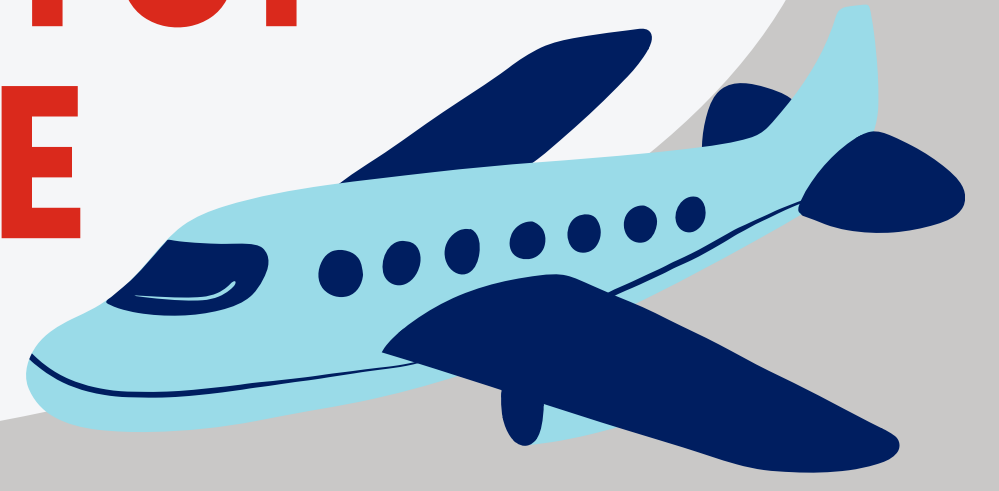
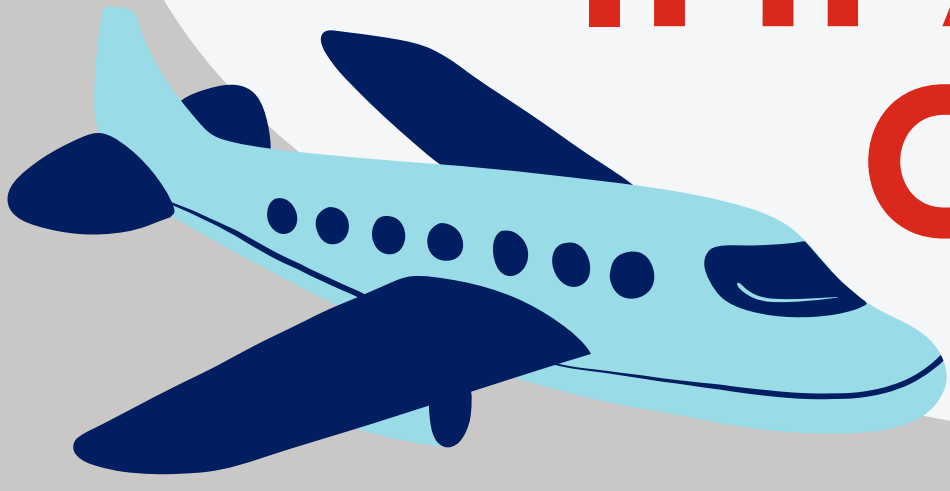


HOW TO GET AROUND SINGAPORE?

Public transportation is widely accessible in Singapore. Students may use their credit/debit card to access public transport. Additionally, transportation cards (Ez-link) are available at the various MRT stations.

Ride Hailing apps like Grab, Gojek, Tada, Ryde and CDG are also available.
