GERMANY

While birth rate declines, mortality falls along side it.

In 2050, Germany would entered Super-Aged Society.

41% of the population is of old age

They implemented Old Age and Disability Insurance in 1884.
Only 137 years ago.

GERMANY

The Statutory Long Term Care Insurance is funded through social securities and government subsidies

Every citizens are guaranteed financially and medically

JAPAN

Currently in Super Aged Society and by 2050, **42.5%** of their population will be of old age

They are way ahead in terms of the implementation of Social Welfare Services for Elderly ,utilised im 1960

JAPAN

Everyone over the age of 40 years old is guaranteed financially and medically.

Each person can inquire to be assisted through different type of care. They will have to pay only **10%-30%** of the medical bills but not exceeding **¥400,000**

SINGAPORE

Slowly entering Old-Age Society and expected that in 2030, 25% of population will be of old age

Established "Blue Paper" or long term care act in 1984.
It is thought of to protect its citizens from financial and medical impediments

SINGAPORE

The scheme is to allow everyone over the age of 40 years old to be guaranteed financially if intensive care is needed.

Providing \$300-\$400 up to 72 months in case of health issue. Also providing long term care for the elderly

Thailand

Is entering Grey generation fastest but nothing tangible is of grasp

Only those who either participate in a public jobs or enrolled in social securities program will be garunteed of medical assistant

Chailand

Will face severe problems if long term care act is not implemented.

Especially with mediocre bureaucracy, such plan is long awaits and unlikely to be passed
