## JENESYS 2.0 Implementation Guidelines

### **“ASEAN Economic Community (AEC) Youth Network: Preparing for the Involvement and Contributions of Youths to the AEC through ASEAN-Japan Youth Exchange Program”**

#### **A. PARTICIPANTS**

##### **A.1 GENERAL ELIGIBILITY**

- The programme is open to youths from the 10 ASEAN Member States (Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam).
- The youths should be between 16-22 years old.
- They should be enrolled as active students in university, academy/diploma program, vocational schools, or the equivalent tertiary/post-high school education;
- They must be able to communicate in English.
- They must be in excellent health, fit to travel, and attend all activities in the program
- Former participants of JENESYS are not eligible to apply

##### **A.2 PROGRAM-SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS**

The program will invite three groups of students from the following backgrounds:

1. **Economics & Social Sciences:** for students with economic-related backgrounds, e.g. development economics, management, trade, investment, business, finance, entrepreneurship, accounting, and others with social sciences background, such as law, politics, sociology, anthropology, psychology, mass communication, etc.
2. **Science & Technology:** for students majoring in science and technology-related fields, e.g. engineering, electronics, information technology, robotics, physics, mathematics, astronomy, biology, and other science backgrounds.

3. **Arts, creative works, & culture:** for students with backgrounds in arts, music, animation, graphic design, cinematography, fashion design, dance, traditional crafts and culture, etc.

Since the main theme throughout this project is the ASEAN Economic Community (AEC), it is advisable that all nominated participants have strong interests in economic development and entrepreneurship regardless of their backgrounds.

### A.3 SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS

- All participants must complete “JENESYS 2.0 Application Form” (See Annex 1)
- Selection of candidates will be conducted by the Embassy of Japan in each ASEAN member States’ capital city in coordination with youth affairs focal points of the respective ASEAN Member States;
- The selection of the candidates will be based on document review (application form) and an interview if applicable by the members of selection committee as arranged by the Embassy of Japan.

### A.4 NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS TO BE SELECTED

The total number of participants to be invited for the AEC Youth Network is 270. The breakdown is illustrated in Table 1.
