The 2015 edition of the TIVA database includes 61 economies covering OECD, EU28, G20, most East and South-east Asian economies and a selection of South American countries. The industry list includes 34 sectors, among which 16 manufacturing and 14 services sectors. The years covered are 1995, 2000, 2005 and 2008 to 2011

The Asian Development Bank has included more Asian countries in the WIOTs in order to facilitate analysis work related to the Asia and the Pacific Region. Five Asian countries (Bangladesh, Malaysia, Philippines, Thailand and Viet Nam) have been added for the years 2000, 2005, 2006, and 2011.
