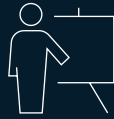

The event is open to current undergraduate students who graduate in 2023 or mid-2024 and recent graduates with less than 2 years of full-time work experience post-graduation.

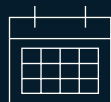
