2. All student enrollment requests have been carefully considered, with approved request lists posted at the attached file. “List of students whose requests are approved for semester 1-2020”

Due to limited classroom size and section numbers possible to offer this semester, requests from students who have already surpassed the quota of five subjects have not been approved.

3) Students who have successfully attained the quota must attend assigned sections.

EE376:

Students who requested EE376 will receive the quota for section 046402. Second-year students who did not request this course may register later during the add & drop period after the semester begins.

EE406:

Students who requested EE406 or registered on BE Portal will receive the quota for sections 046401 & 02. Students may select the section at Reg TU (July 29 - 30). Second-year students who did not request this course may only register for EE406 at section 046403 on Reg TU (July 30).

EE200:

Second-year students who requested EE200 will be automatically added to section 046402. Second-year students interested in this course may register later during the add & drop period after the semester begins.

4) Upper-year students who register for ST216 on BE-Portal and plan to retake it will be automatically added to section 046403.

5) During add & drop period, the enrollment on additional course sections offered will be limited to second-year students only. All second-year students with insufficient enrollment credits are advised to enroll in the additional course sections offered.

**Please note that half of total credits enrolled per semester must be EE-titled and Gen Ed Part I/II courses. For the current semester, Gen Ed part II includes BA291, TU122 and HR201.**

6) The B.E. International Program will soon conduct a survey of course demand for semester 2/2020. Survey results will determine the number of future sections offered.
